
Immediately arrange home and contents insurance

Collect the keys from the real estate agent

Contact the real estate agent to arrange collection of the keys to the property. If the property was the Seller's principal place of residence, they have until 12 noon on the day after settlement to move out and hand over the keys. Otherwise, they must hand the keys over as soon as settlement is complete.


